






Overview

In certain circumstances, a proctor may need to interrupt a test. If the circumstance compromises test security or integrity, the test should be aborted if web-based, or destroyed if paper-based, and the student should take the alternate form at the same level test upon return. Proctors should follow the local policy of their agency for permissible interruptions that are not likely to compromise test integrity.

- Proctors may **Interrupt a Test** from the
 - o Testing Station, or the
 - Management Console.
- Proctors use one of two methods for interrupting a test
 - **1.** From the **Testing Station**
 - Proctors use the **Ctrl** + **E** key-command.
 - 2. From the Management Console
 - Proctors use the Intervene button.
- Proctors may choose one of **four** options for interrupting a test-in-progress –



- Most interruptions with testing can be resolved within the local agency. Examples of testing interruptions include but are not limited to the following:
 - Administering the wrong test
 - Cheating
 - Illness during testing
 - o Sudden, urgent, usually unexpected occurrence requiring immediate action
 - o Computer malfunction
 - Lost connection to Internet
- Testing Irregularity
 - When a testing irregularity cannot be resolved at the local agency, please submit a <u>Testing Irregularity Report (TIR)</u> within the same day of the occurrence, or the next day at the very latest. CASAS will use this information to investigate.




Steps to Interrupt a Test-in-Progress


Score the Test

If a student indicates they are finished with the test, and the student spent enough time on the test even though time may remain to complete the test, you may **Interrupt** and **Score the Test**-in-progress. This may be done at the Testing Station or the Management Console.


- To view each other's screen during each activity, pair-with the person seated next to you and decide who will be the **Proctor**, and who will be the **Student**.
- You may also have a group of three with one proctor in the middle and two students on each side.





Abort the Test

If a student just began taking a test (less than five items) and does not have enough time to complete the test in one sitting, or the test appears not to be the correct test for the student, you may **Interrupt** and **Abort the Test**-in-progress. This may be done at the **Testing Station** or the **Management Console**.





Exit the Test

If a student has been taking a test and cannot complete the test in the sitting, you may Interrupt and Exit the Test-in-progress. This will suspend the test until the student can return and finish. This may be done at the Testing Station or the Management Console.

CAUTION! Suspending a test should *only* be done on rare occasion and *not* routine practice. Any suspended test may compromise test security or integrity of the assessment. Proctors should follow the local policy of their agency for permissible interruptions that are not likely to compromise test security or test integrity.





Reconnect a Suspended Test

When a student returns to complete a suspended test, the proctor must reconnect the test before the student may continue and finish the test. This is done at the **Management Console**.



Pause the Test

If a student needs to take a brief break during the test, you may Interrupt and Pause the Test-in-progress. This can only be done at the Testing Station.



Reporting a Testing Irregularity to CASAS

When a testing irregularity cannot be resolved at the local agency, please submit a Testing Irregularity Report (TIR) within the same day of the occurrence, or the next day at the very latest. CASAS will use this information to investigate.

How to complete and submit the TIR:

- **1. COPY** the fillable TIR to your computer.
- 2. **OPEN** the fillable TIR from your computer and fill in the information.
- **3. SAVE** the completed TIR to your computer.
- 4. ATTACH the completed TIR to an e-mail and send to techsupport@casas.org.

Note! If the same irregularity occurred with multiple students in the same session, submit one form.
