

## 2023 Federal Poverty Income Guidelines

### CSBG Income Eligibility:

A household is eligible for CSBG services if their combined income from all sources, except food programs, falls at or below 100% of Federal Poverty Income Guidelines for the number of persons in the household. Additionally, the household must reside in Sacramento County or be homeless.

A household is determined eligible for CSBG services if the household's total monthly cash income before taxes falls at or below 100% of poverty income guidelines, or if anyone in the household receives CalWORKs and the household's total monthly cash income before taxes falls at or below 125% of poverty income guidelines.
