

VOLUNTARY SELF-IDENTIFICATION

The Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) requires all public employers complete an EEO-4 report every other year. Covered employers must invite employees to self-identify race/ethnicity for this report.

Completion of this form is voluntary and will not affect your opportunity for employment, or the terms or conditions of your employment. This form will be used for EEO-4 reporting purposes only and will be kept separate from all other personnel records only accessed by the Human Resources department.

If you choose not to self-identify your race/ethnicity at this time, the federal government requires SETA to determine this information by visual survey and/or other available information.
