Re: Letter of Understanding on the Addition of the Juneteenth Holiday

Dear Wendy:

This is to confirm the agreement of the Sacramento Employment and Training Agency (SETA) and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees District Council 57, Local 146, AFL-CIO (AFSCME) to a letter of understanding amending Sections 9.1(a) of the Agreement covering Head Start employees, the Agreement covering Clerical, Technical and Analytical employees, and the Agreement covering Supervisory employees covering holidays. After meeting on the matter the parties agreed to add Juneteenth as a holiday effective in 2023.
